OUT OF OUR LEAGUE: The Pac-10 posted a solid 25-12 (.676) mark against non-conference foes in 1998, highlighted by Arizona's 5-0 mark against outsiders. Here is how the Pac-10 stacked up vs. the Division I-A conferences this year: Big Ten (4-1), Big 12 (4-3), ACC (1-1), Big East (0-1), WAC (6-4), Conference USA (2-0), Big West (6-0) and Division I-A independents (2-2).

1998 PAC-10 HOME ATTENDANCE--SECOND HIGHEST IN HISTORY: More than three million fans attended Pac-10 football games this season as the league recorded its second-highest figures ever in both total attendance and average attendance. A total of 3,059,202 fans attended 60 home games for an average of 50,987 per contest. Those figures trail only the record attendance year of 1988 when Pac-10 teams averaged 51,279 per contest.
